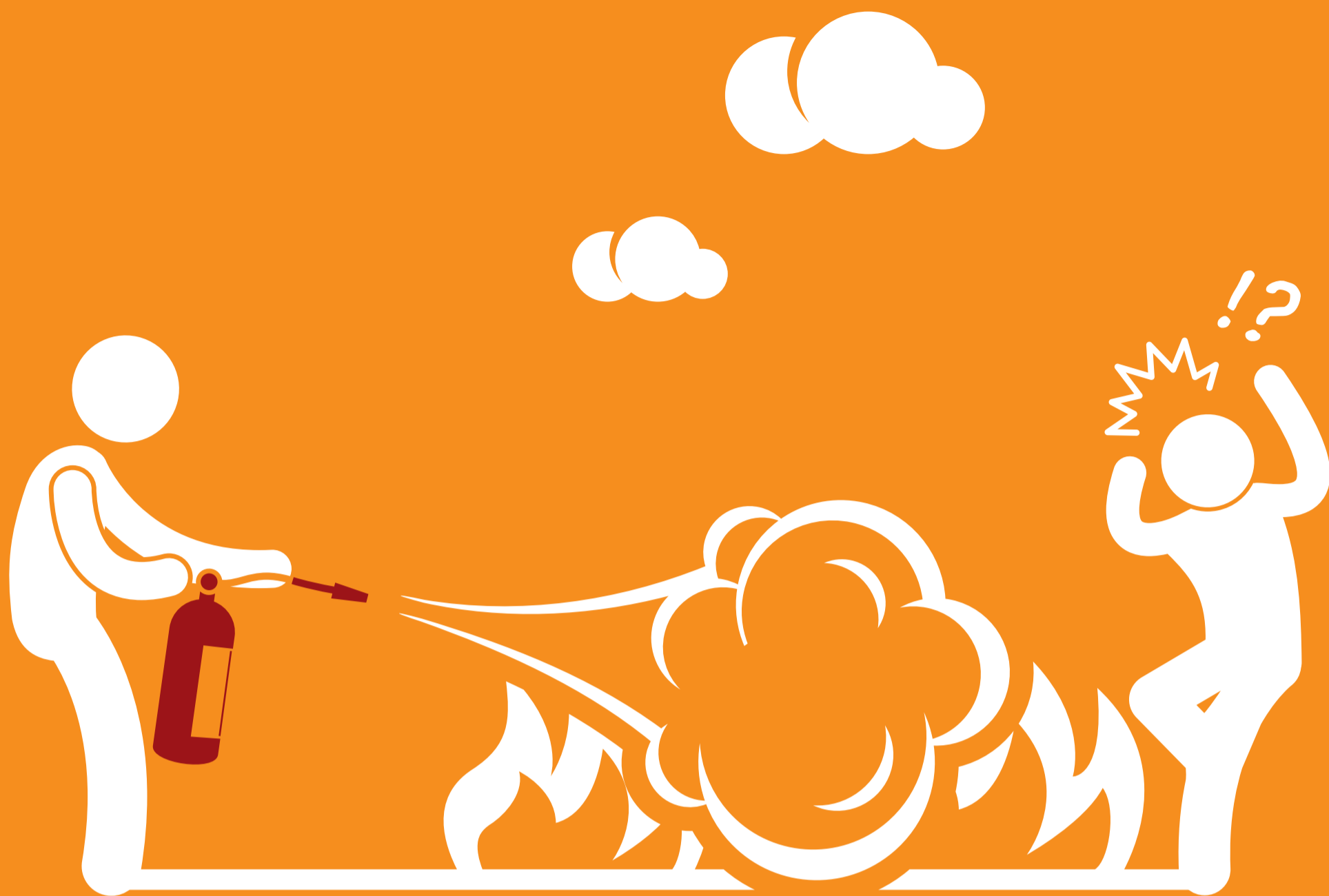


NOT IN OUR PARKS!
